ACCEPTABLE ITEMS



GLASS

All containers must be clean and empty

- Food and beverage containers



METALS

- Empty aerosol cans
- Metal food and beverage containers
- Aluminum foil



MIXED PAPER/CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

- All paper
- Milk and juice cartons
- Catalogs and phone books
- Cardboard boxes (broken down/flattened)
- Frozen food packaging
- Hard and soft-covered books
- Paper bags and wrapping paper
- Magazines
- Newspapers with inserts
- Paper board (cereal and cracker boxes)



PLASTIC

- Drinking cups
- Flower pots
- Narrow-neck containers with resin identification numbers 1, 2, 3, 5, 7 (on bottom)
- Wide-mouth containers (peanut butter, yogurt, cottage cheese, sour cream, mayonnaise, whipped topping, margarine/butter tubs and prescription bottles)

Remember to rinse all food and beverage containers. Caps may be placed back on bottles.

* Recycle your CLEAN and DRY plastic bags at most grocery stores and other retailers instead of placing it in your recycling bin or cart.

SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING

Recycling is easy, saves energy and is good for our environment.

- Place all recyclable items in the same container.
- Equipment at the Recycling Facility sorts them.
- Any receptacle marked with an "X" or the word "Recycling" may be used as a recycling collection container.

YELLOW BINS AND TOTERS

- Toters hold more recyclables in one container.
- Toters keep the contents dry.
- Toters are easy to wheel out to the curb.
- Yellow bins are compact for small spaces and may be used for overflow or materials that do not fit in your cart.
- All toters and bins are the property of Prince George's County.

COLLECTIONS

- Place your recycling container at the curb by 6 a.m. on your designated pick up day. Collections continue until 8 p.m.
- When placing the container at the curb, the arrow on the lid and the lift bar should be facing the street and nothing should be in front of the container.
- For missed collections, please contact CountyClick 3-1-1 or environment.mypgc.us.

COLLECTION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS AND THE DISABLED

On-premise collection of trash, recyclables and household hazardous waste is available for seniors and disabled persons. For more information, contact CountyClick 3-1-1 or environment.mypgc.us.

HOLIDAYS

Recycling collection will not be provided on New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day. If the holiday falls on a week day, recycling collection will shift to the next day, through Saturday, with no collections on Sunday.

County residents may use the following County-owned and operated drop-off centers for the disposal of recyclables and rigid plastics:

METALES

- Latas vacías de aerosol
- Envases de alimentos y bebidas hechos de aluminio, bimetálico, ferrosos y acero
- Papel de aluminio



PAPEL MIXTO/CARTÓN CORRUGADO

- Todo tipo de papel
- Cartones de leche y jugo asépticos
- Catálogos
- Cajas de cartón corrugado (descompuesto / aplanado)
- Envoltura de alimentos congelados
- Libros con pastas duras y blandas
- Bolsas de papel marca Kraft y papel de envoltura
- Revistas
- Periódicos con insertos
- Cartón (cajas de cereales y galletas)
- Guías de teléfonos



PLÁSTICO

- Copas
- Macetas
- Envases de cuello estrecho con números de identificación de resina 1, 2, 3, 5, 7
- Envases de boca ancha (mantequilla de maní, yogurt, requesón, crema agria, mayonesa, crema batida, margarina/tinas de mantequilla y botellas recetadas)

Recuerde enjuagar todos los envases de alimentos y bebidas. Las tapas pueden colocarse de nuevo en las botellas.

* Recicle sus bolsas de plástico limpias y secas en la mayoría de las tiendas de comestibles y otros minoristas en lugar de colocarlas en su recipiente o contenedor de reciclaje.

Reciclar es fácil, ahorra energía y es bueno para nuestro medio ambiente

- Coloque todos los artículos reciclables en el mismo contenedor
- El equipo en la Planta de Reciclaje los clasifica
- Cualquier receptáculo marcado con una "X" o la palabra "Reciclaje" puede usarse como un contenedor de recolección de reciclaje

CONTENEDORES AMARILLOS Y RECIPIENTES

- Los recipientes de basura sostienen más materiales reciclables en el contenedor
- Los recipientes mantienen el contenido seco.
- Los recipientes son fáciles de girar hacia fuera a la acera.
- Los contenedores amarillos son compactos para espacios pequeños y pueden ser utilizados para exceso de materiales y aquellos materiales que no quepan en el contenedor exterior.
- Los residentes pueden continuar reciclando en recipientes amarillos.

COLECCIONES

- Coloque sus recipientes de reciclaje en la acera antes de las 6 a.m. en su día de recolección designado. Las colecciones continúan hasta las 8 p.m.
- Al colocar el contenedor en el bordillo, la flecha en la tapa y la barra de elevación deben estar mirando hacia la calle y nada debe estar delante del contenedor.
- Para colecciones perdidas, por favor comuníquese con CountyClick 3-1-1 o environment.mypgc.us.

COLLECTION PARA CIUDADANOS MAYORES Y PERSONAS DISCAPACITADAS

DIAS FESTIVOS

No se proporcionará recolección de reciclado el día de Año Nuevo, Día Conmemorativo, Día de la Independencia, Día del Trabajador, Día de Acción de Gracias o Día de Navidad. Si el día festivo cae en un día de la semana, la colección del reciclaje cambiará al día siguiente, hasta el sábado, sin colecciones el domingo.

**PLASTIC BAGS ARE NO LONGER ACCEPTED
IN YOUR RECYCLING BIN OR CART**

HERE'S WHAT NOT TO RECYCLE



- ▶ Any grocery, retail or trash plastic bag
- ▶ Bread bags
- ▶ Dry cleaning bags
- ▶ Fruit and vegetable bags (fresh/frozen)
- ▶ Garden product bags (soil/mulch)
- ▶ Newspaper bags
- ▶ Outer wrap from paper towel, napkin and diaper packages
- ▶ Outer wrap from cases of soda, juice and snacks
- ▶ Zipper or stand-up pouches, bubble or cling wrap
- ▶ Crinkle bags for cereal, pasta or snack bags
- ▶ Outer wrap from meat or cheese products

Plastic bags are no longer being accepted in your recycling bin or cart



Recycle your clean and dry plastic bags at most grocery stores and other retailers instead of placing it in your recycling bin or cart. Use reusable bags or totes when shopping or opt for paper bags where available.

Here's what NOT to recycle



Any grocery, retail or trash plastic bag

Outer wrap from paper towel, napkin and diaper packages

Bread bags

Outer wrap from cases of soda, juice and snacks

Dry cleaning bags/*Wire & Plastic Clothes Hangers

Zipper or stand-up pouches, bubble or cling wrap

Fruit and vegetable bags (fresh/frozen)

Crinkle bags for cereal, pasta or snack bags

Garden product bags (soil/mulch)

Outer wrap from meat or cheese products

Newspaper bags

**Note: These items cause severe damage to the sorting equipment at the MRF. When possible, return hangers to the dry cleaners for reuse, or dispose of them at the County's Convenience Centers.*



Here's what NOT to recycle ►

DON'T PUT IT IN THE BIN

Whether recycling at work or at home, pay close attention to place appropriate materials in the correct container. Contamination is costly; causing loss of valuable natural resources and revenue. Last year the County paid thousands of dollars in fees due to damages caused by unacceptable materials being tossed in recycling containers. Pay close attention to posters and information above or on each recycling receptacle, most are marked with the acceptable items.

Unacceptable items include:

- ▶ Food
- ▶ Plastic bags and wraps
- ▶ Plastic utensils
- ▶ Tissues and paper towels
- ▶ Chip bags



Contamination is costly; remember when in doubt leave it out!

WHAT CAN I RECYCLE?



Mixed Paper / Corrugated Cardboard

including flattened cardboard boxes*, newspaper, hard and soft covered books, office paper, catalogs, telephone books, envelopes

**if cardboard boxes are too large for the recycling collection container place them next to or behind the receptacle.*

Plastic Containers • Glass • Aluminum

including narrow-neck and wide mouth food and beverage containers*, bottles, cans, jars, yogurt cups**

**with resin identification numbers 1 through 7*

***containers should be empty and may be recapped with lids*

WHAT SHOULD GO IN THE TRASH?



Do not place the following items
in the recycling container

Food
Contaminated paper plates
Styrofoam
Plastic bags/film
Chip bags
Candy wrappers

Botellas de vidrio + Tarros • Bolsas de papel, Todo tipo de papel, papel de regalo + periódico • Envases de plástico de boca ancha, tapas • Cartón corrugado, carton • Cartones con tapa de cartón, envoltura de alimentos congelados • Libros telefónicos, Revistas, correo no deseado, Libros

BEFORE placing in collection bin or cart, rinse or wipe containers.

Antes de colocar artículos o recipientes en el compartimiento o carro de recolección, asegúrese de enjuagar o limpiarlos.

COMBINE all recycling items for collection, but when in doubt, leave it out!
